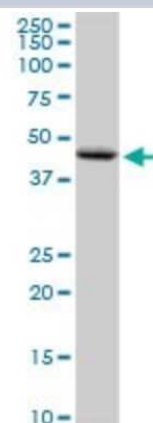

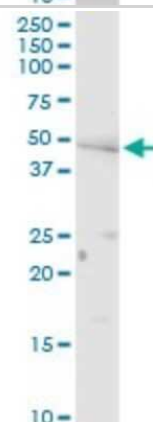

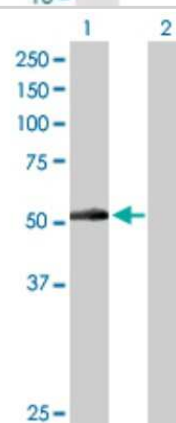
Western Blot: Adiponutrin/PNPLA3 Antibody [H00080339-D01P] -
