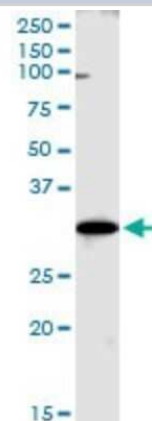

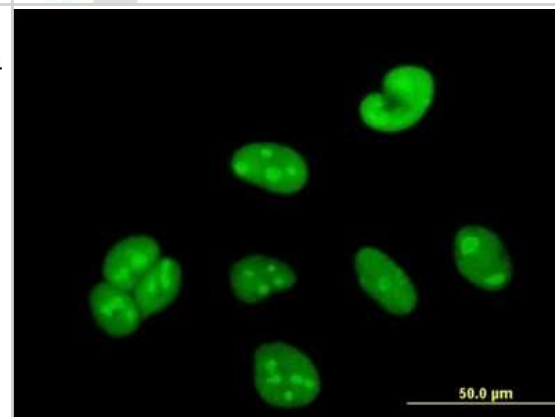

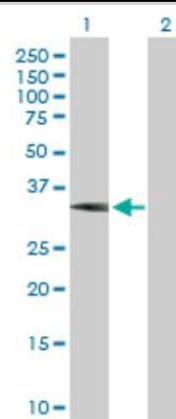
Western Blot: WBSCR22 Antibody [H00114049-B01P] - Analysis of WBSCR22 expression in HeLa S3 NE.
