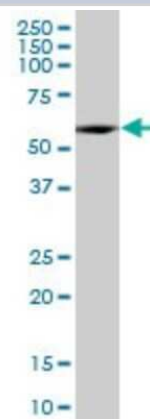

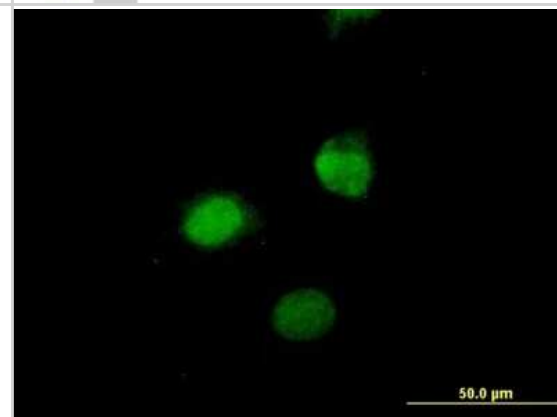

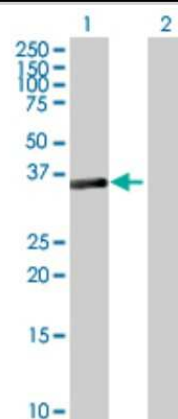
Western Blot: SESN3 Antibody [H00143686-B01P] - Analysis of SESN3 expression in human liver.
