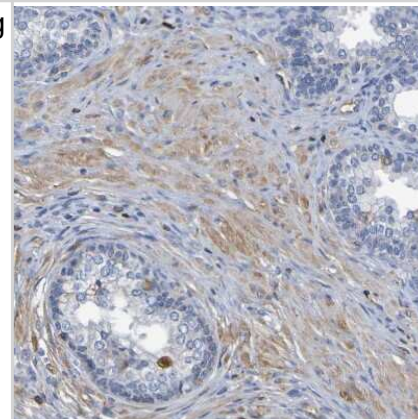

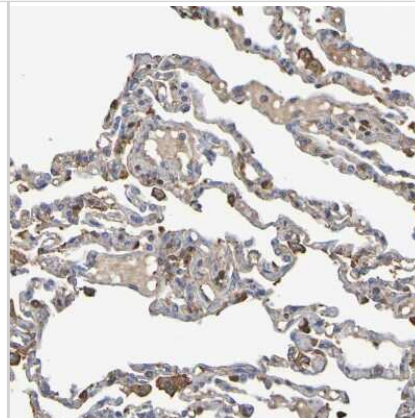

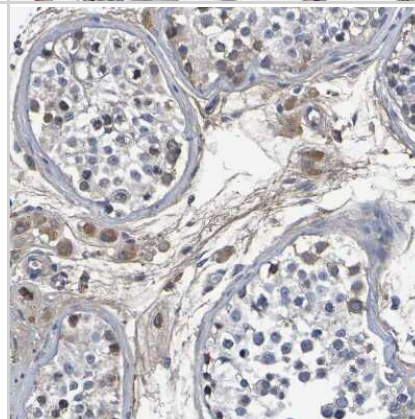

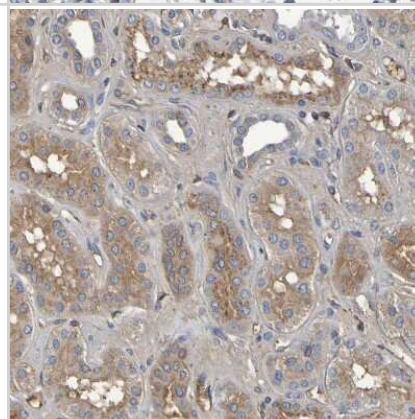
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: GAB3 Antibody [NBP1-86111] - Staining of human lung shows moderate membranous positivity in macrophages.

Lane 1: Marker [kDa] 230, 130, 95, 72, 56, 36, 28, 17, 11

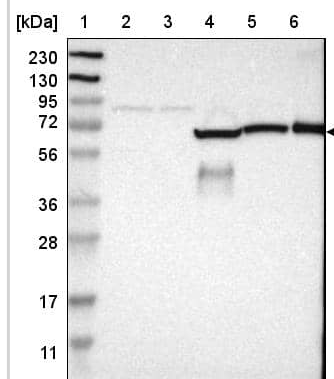
Lane 2: Human cell line RT-4
