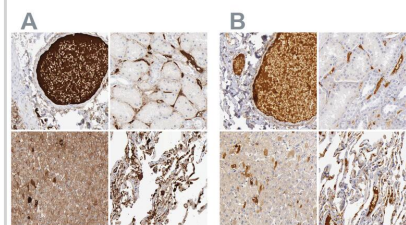

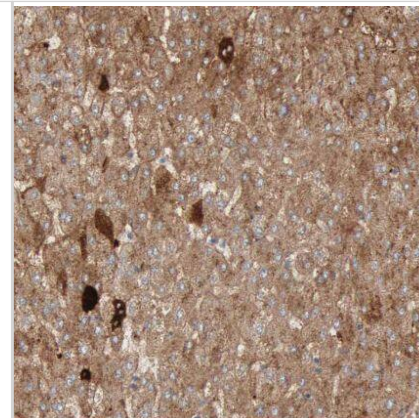

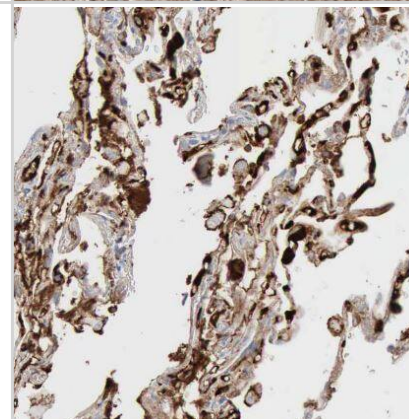

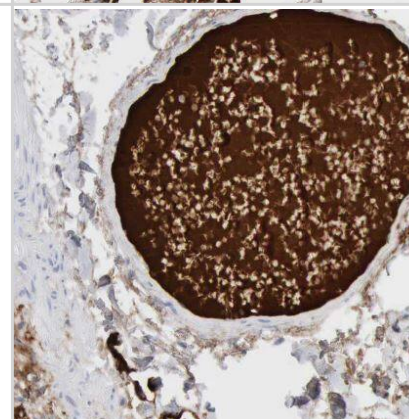

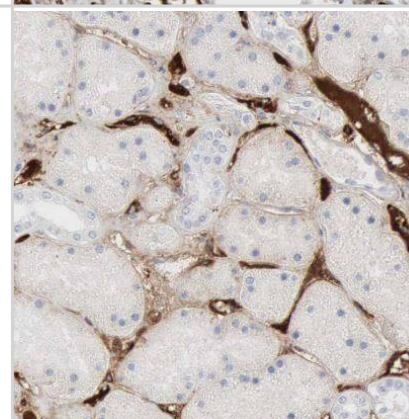

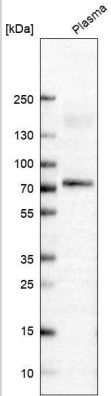
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: C4 binding protein A Antibody [NBP1-88263] -Staining of human colon shows strong positivity in plasma.
