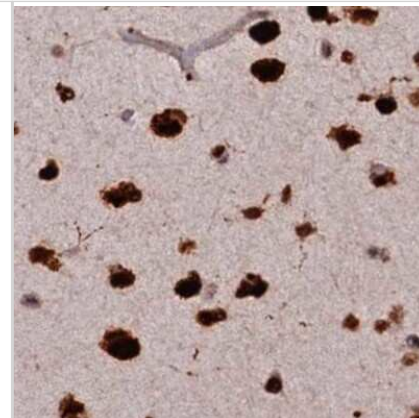

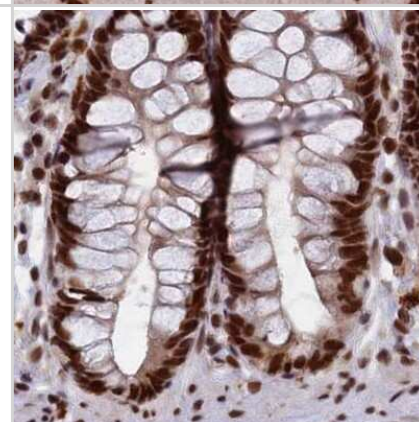

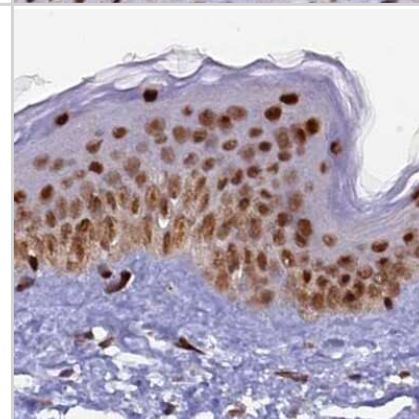
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: FAM103A1 Antibody [NBP1-88436] - Staining of human cerebral cortex.



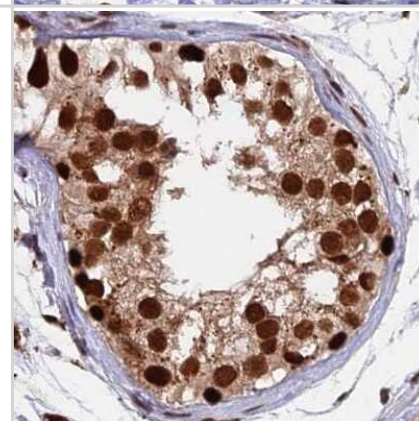
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: FAM103A1 Antibody [NBP1-88436] - Staining of human colon.



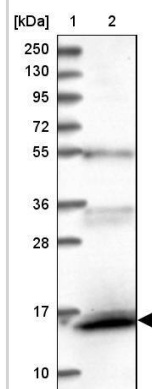
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: FAM103A1 Antibody [NBP1-88436] - Staining of human skin.
