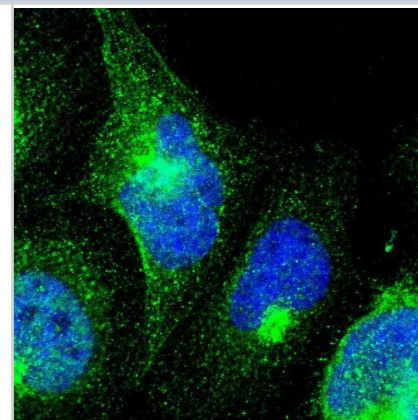

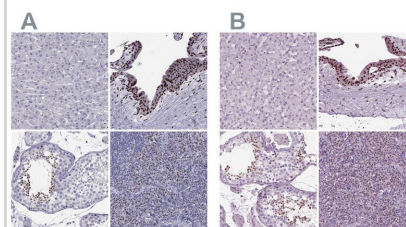

Staining of human cell line U-2 OS shows localization to nucleoplasm, cytosol & vesicles.



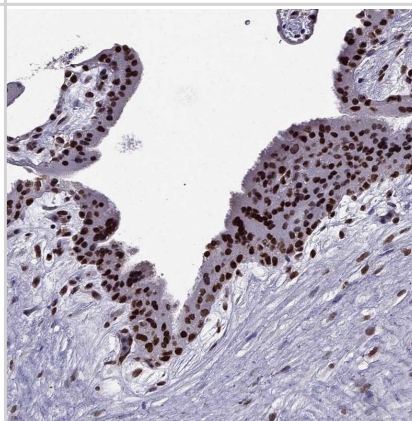

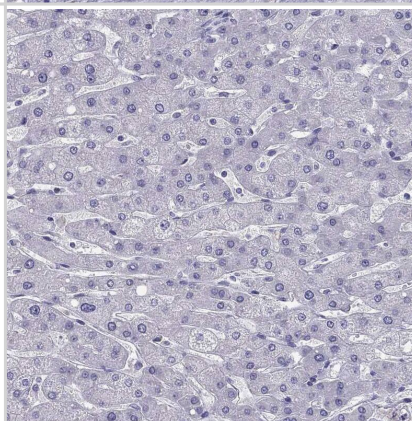
Analysis in human placenta and liver tissues using NBP1-89938 antibody. Corresponding ARID3A RNA-seq data are presented for the same tissues.



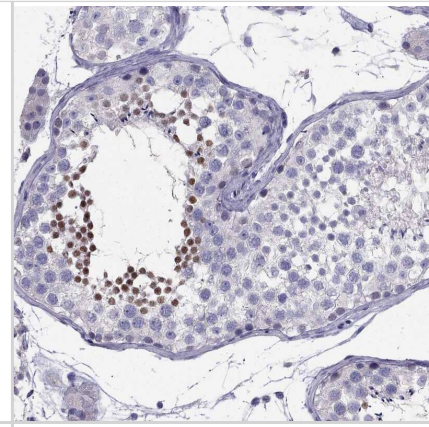
Staining of human placenta shows strong nuclear positivity in trophoblastic cells.



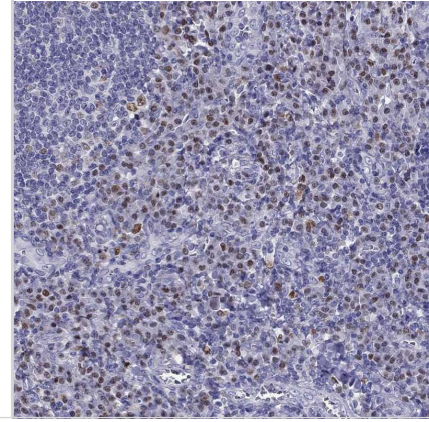
Staining of human liver shows no positivity in hepatocytes as expected.
