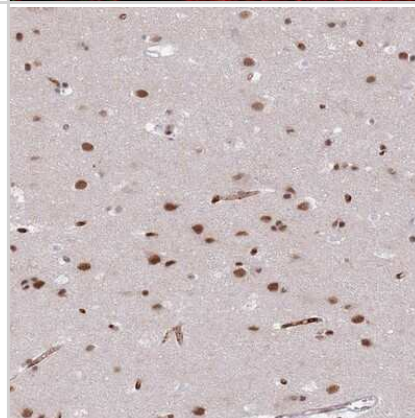

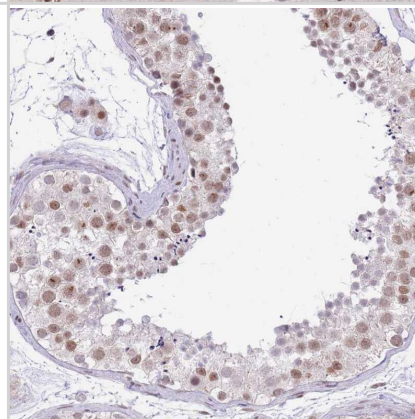

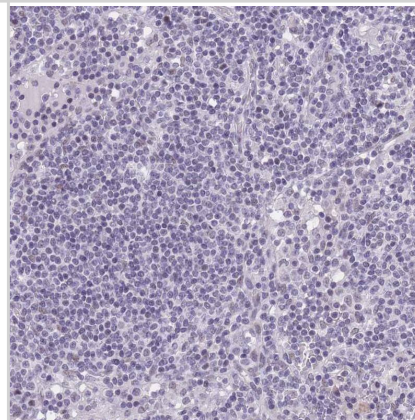

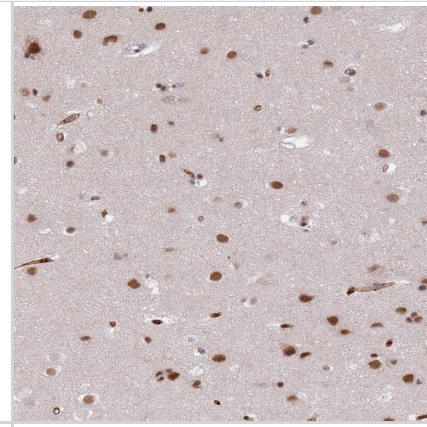
Staining of human testis shows moderate nuclear positivity in cells in seminiferous ducts.



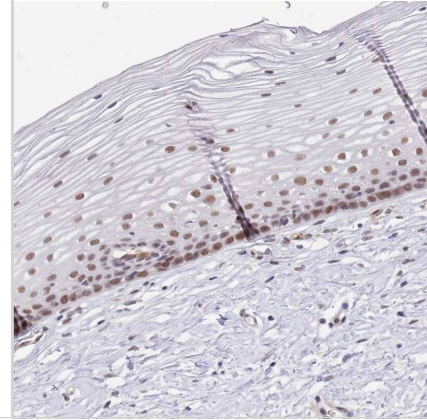
Staining of human lymph node shows no positivity in non-germinal center cells as expected.
