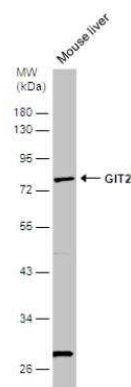

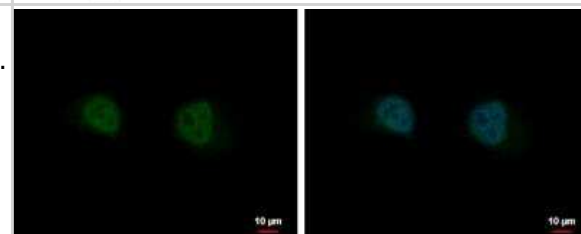

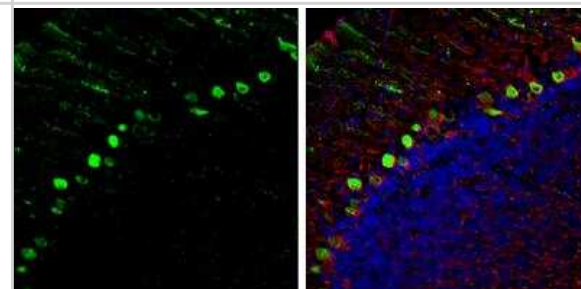
Western Blot: GIT2 Antibody [NBP2-16661] - Mouse tissue extract (50 ug) was separated by 10% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with GIT2 antibody [N1N3] diluted at 1:1000.



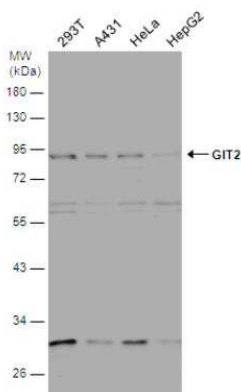
Immunocytochemistry/Immunofluorescence: GIT2 Antibody [NBP2-16661] - HeLa cells were fixed in 4% paraformaldehyde at RT for 15 min. Green: GIT2 protein stained by GIT2 antibody [N1N3] diluted at 1:500. Blue: Hoechst 33342 staining. Scale bar = 10 um.

Green: GIT2 protein stained by GIT2 antibody diluted at 1:250. Red: NF-H, stained by NF-H antibody diluted at 1:500. Blue: Fluoroshield with DAPI.
