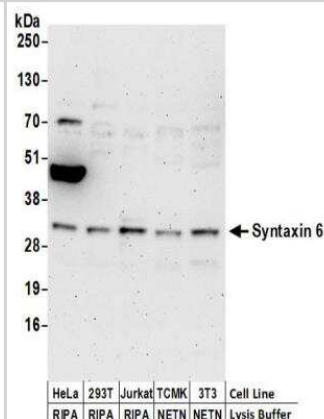

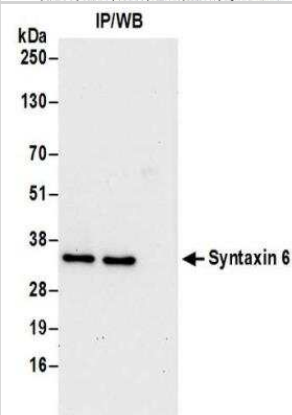

**Western Blot: Syntaxin 6 Antibody [NBP2-32270]** - Samples: Whole cell lysate (50 ug) prepared using NETN or RIPA buffer from HeLa, 293T, Jurkat, mouse TCMK-1, and mouse NIH3T3 cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Syntaxin 6 antibody NBP2-32270 used for WB at 0.1 ug/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 3 minutes.



**Immunoprecipitation: Syntaxin 6 Antibody [NBP2-32270]** - Samples: Whole cell lysate (0.5 or 1.0 mg per IP reaction; 20% of IP loaded) prepared using RIPA buffer from Jurkat cells. Antibodies: Affinity purified rabbit anti-Syntaxin 6 antibody NBP2-32270 used for IP at 6 ug per reaction. Syntaxin 6 was also immunoprecipitated by rabbit anti-Syntaxin 6 antibody BL16441. For blotting immunoprecipitated Syntaxin 6, NBP2-32270 was used at 1 ug/ml. Detection: Chemiluminescence with an exposure time of 30 seconds.
