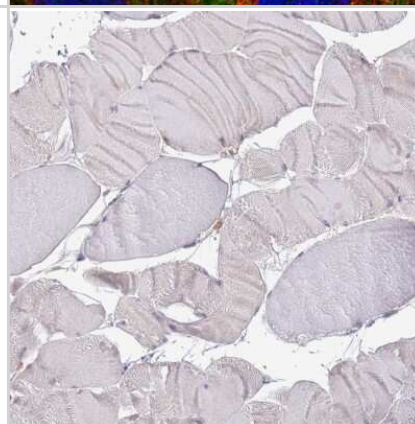

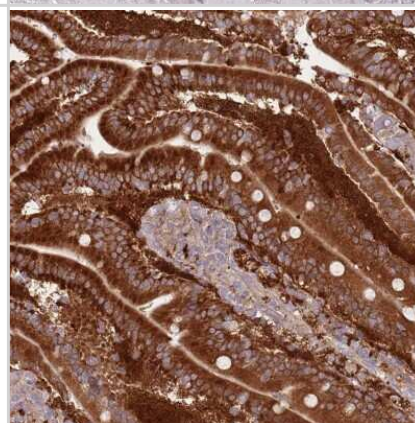

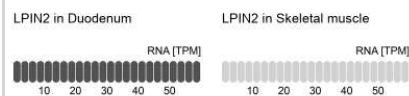
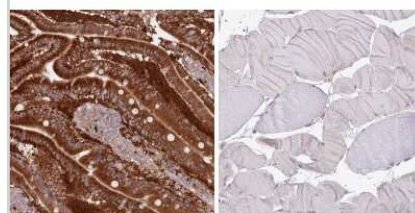
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Lipin 2 Antibody [NBP2-33931] - Staining of human skeletal muscle shows low expression as expected.
