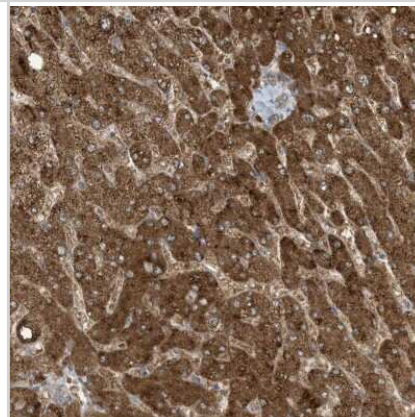

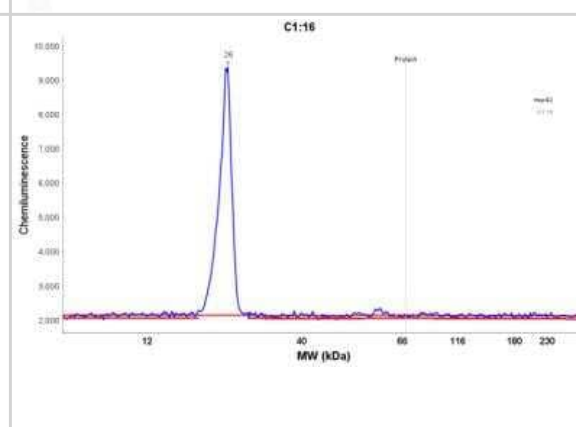
Immunohistochemistry: ADI1 Antibody [NBP2-38251] - Staining of human liver shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in hepatocytes.
