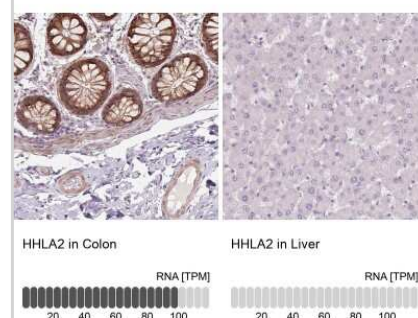

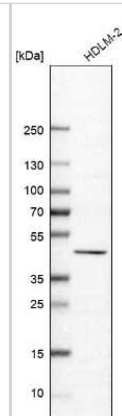

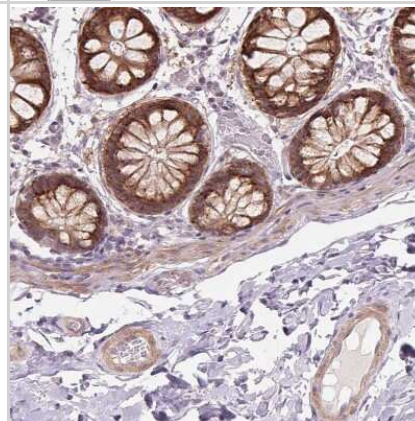

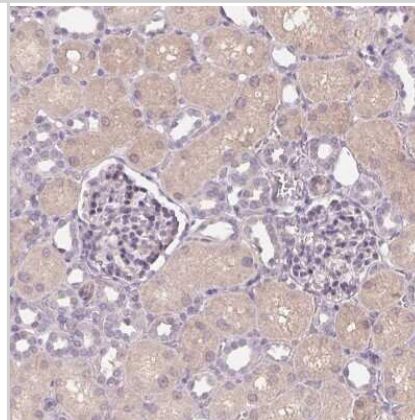
Western Blot: B7-H7/HLA2 Antibody [NBP2-49187] - Analysis in human cell line HDLM-2.



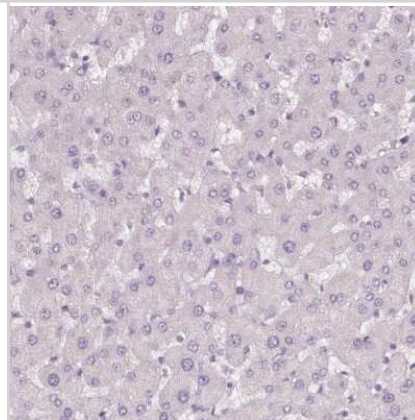

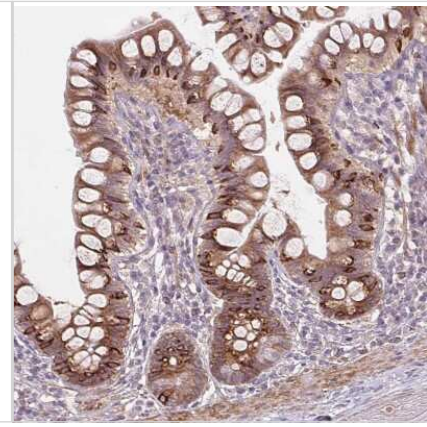
