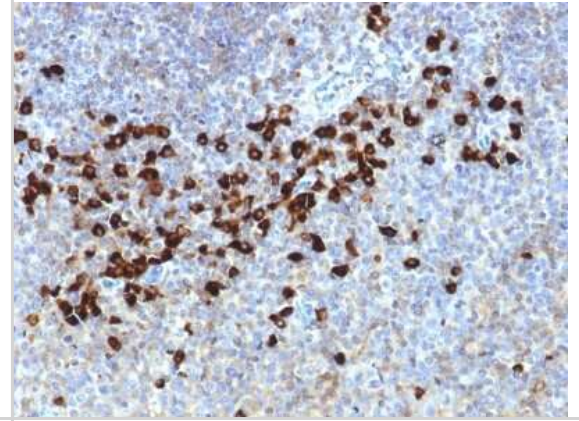

Description	200ug/ml of antibody purified from Bioreactor Concentrate by Protein A or G. Prepared in 10 mM PBS with 0.05% BSA & 0.05% azide. Also available WITHOUT BSA & azide at 1.0 mg/ml. (NBP2-54420) Antibody with azide - store at 2 to 8C. Antibody without azide - store at -20 to -80C.

Specificity/Sensitivity	This monoclonal antibody is specific to Lambda Light Chain of immunoglobulin and shows no cross-reaction with Lambda Light Chain or any of the five heavy chains. In mammals, the two light chains in an antibody are always identical, with only one type of light chain, kappa or lambda. The ratio of Kappa to Lambda is 70:30. However, with the occurrence of multiple myeloma or other B-cell malignancies this ratio is disturbed. Antibody to the Lambda Light Chain is reportedly useful in the identification of leukemias, plasmacytomas, and certain non-Hodgkins lymphomas. Demonstration of clonality in lymphoid infiltrates indicates that the infiltrate is malignant.

Recommended Dilutions	Immunohistochemistry, Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin 0.1-0.2 ug/ml
Application Notes	Immunohistochemistry (Formalin-fixed): 0.1-0.2ug/ml for 30 min at RT. Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires heating tissue sections in 10mM Tris with 1mM EDTA, pH 9.0, for 45 min at 95C followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes. Optimal dilution for a specific application should be determined.

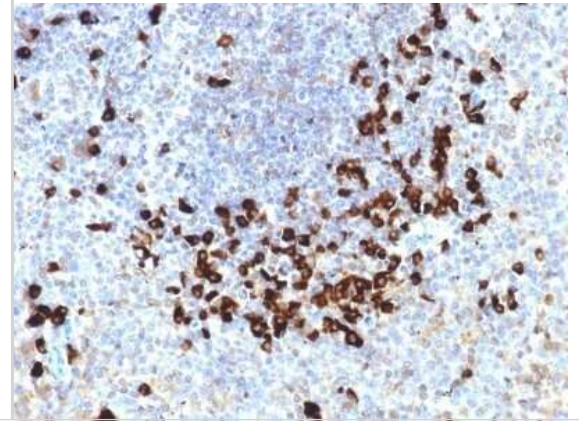
