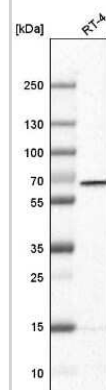

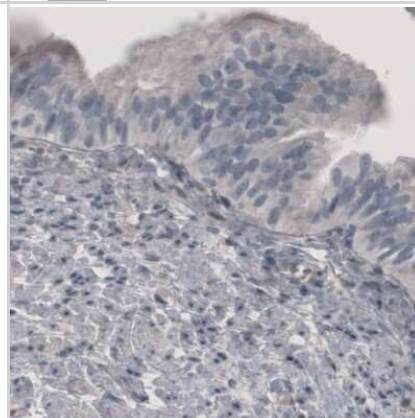

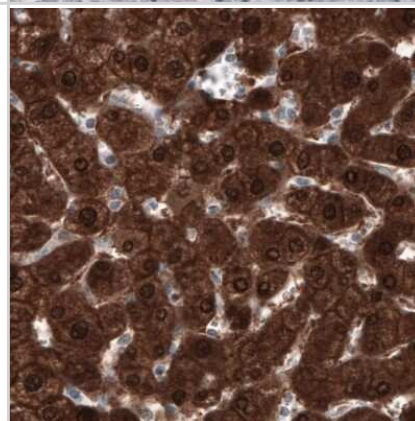
Western Blot: PGM1 Antibody (CL3301) [NBP2-59026] - Analysis in human cell line RT-4.



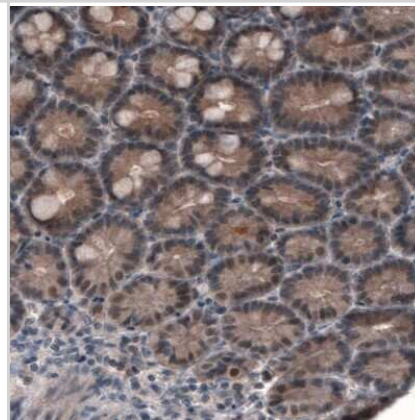
