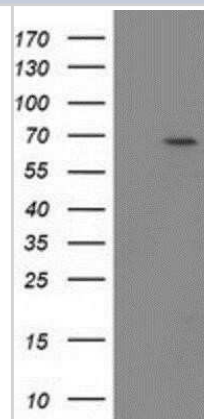

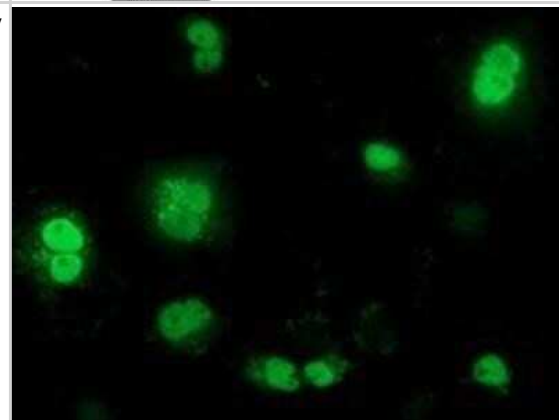

Western Blot: beta-TrCP1/BTRC Antibody (OTI3D5) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP2-71401] - HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY betaTrCP (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-betaTrCP.
