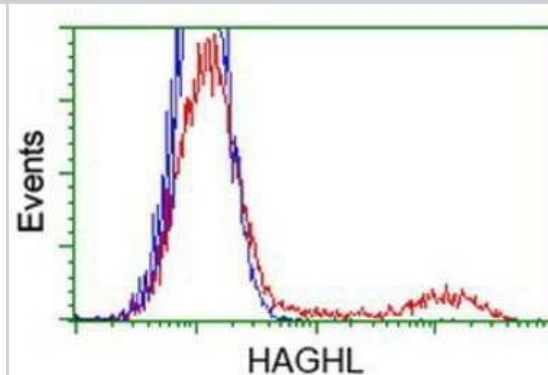

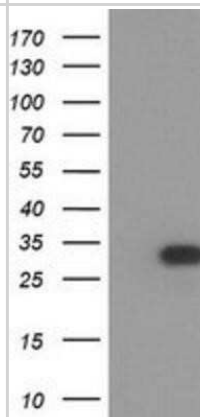

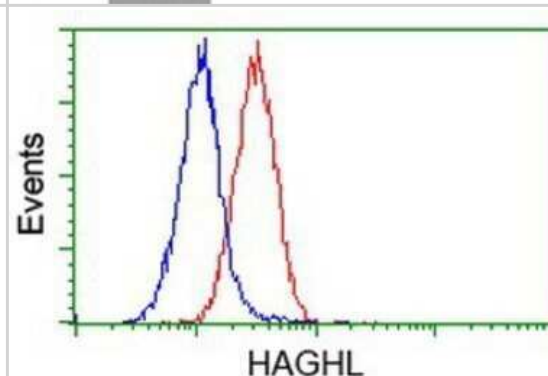
Flow Cytometry: HAGHL Antibody (OTI3H2) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP2-72283] - HEK293T cells transfected with either overexpression plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostaining by anti-HAGHL antibody, and then analyzed by flow cytometry.



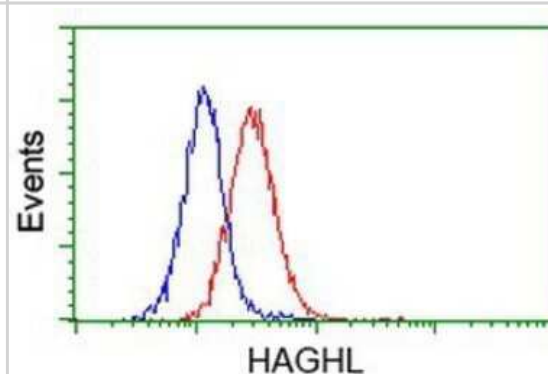
Flow Cytometry: HAGHL Antibody (OTI3H2) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP2-72283] - HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY HAGHL (Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-HAGHL.
