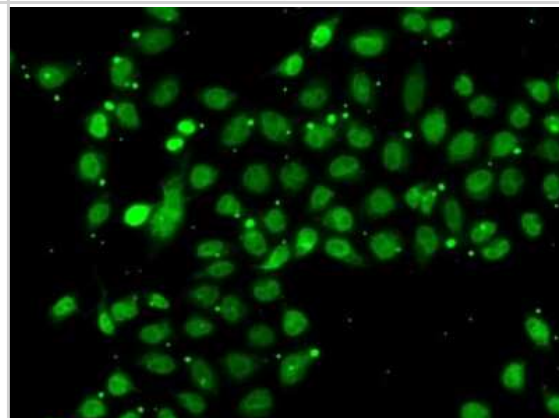

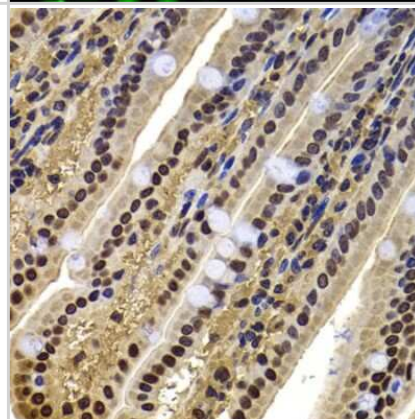

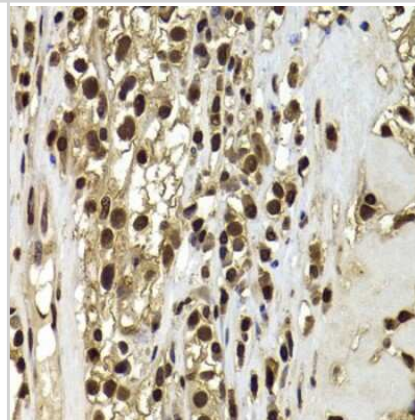
Immunocytochemistry/Immunofluorescence: ACTL6B Antibody [NBP2-92909] - Analysis of A-549 cells using ACTL6B .



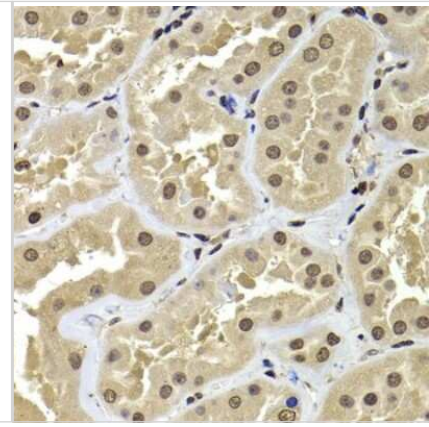
