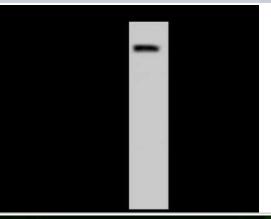

Immunocytochemistry/Immunofluorescence: UTP18 Antibody [NBP2-97492] - Immunofluorescence staining of UTP18 in A431 cells. Cells were fixed with 4% PFA, permeabilzed with 0.1% Triton X-100 in PBS, blocked with 10% serum, and incubated with rabbit anti-Human UTP18 polyclonal antibody (dilution ratio 1:200) at 4C overnight. Then cells were stained with the Alexa Fluor(R)488-conjugated Goat Anti-rabbit IgG secondary antibody (green). Positive staining was localized to Nucleus.



Immunoprecipitation: UTP18 Antibody [NBP2-97492] - UTP18 was immunoprecipitated using: Lane A: 0.5 mg U-251MG Whole Cell Lysate 4 ul anti-UTP18 rabbit polyclonal antibody and 60 ug of Immunomagnetic beads Protein A/G.
