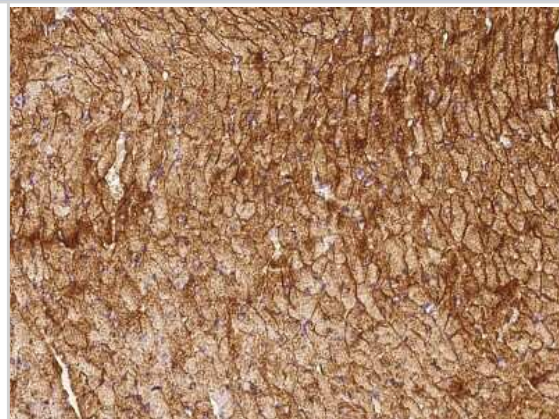

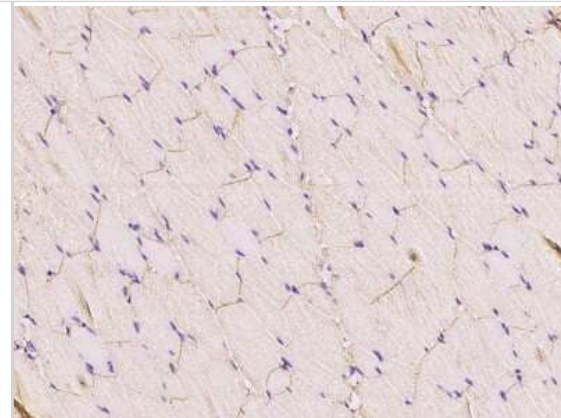

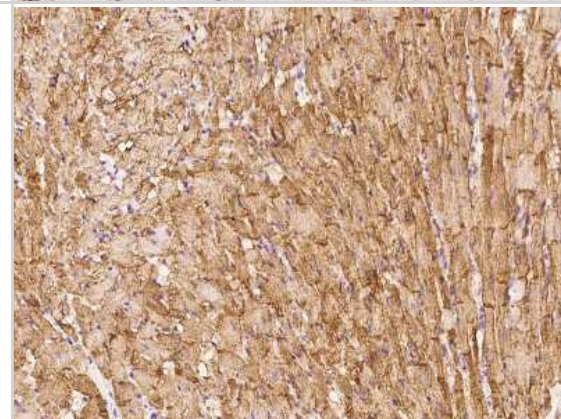

polyclonal antibody (1:2000, formalin-fixed paraffin embedded sections)



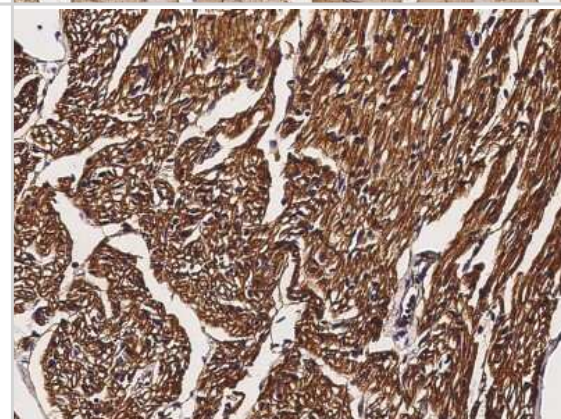
