Specificity/Sensitivity	Several isoforms of IRF7 are known to exist. Human IRF7 has 4 isoforms, including isoform A (503aa, 54kD), isoform B (474aa, 52kD), isoform C (164aa, 18kD) and isoform D (516aa, 56kD). Mouse IRF7 has one isoform (457aa, 51kD) and Rat IRF7 also has one isoform (456aa, 51kD). NBP3-06987 can detect human isoforms and mouse, and possibly can detect rat.
Immunogen	Antibody was raised against a peptide corresponding to 17 amino acids near the center of human IRF7. The immunogen is located within amino acids 200-230 of IRF7.
