It is expressed, typically at high levels, on peripheral T cells and majority of T cell neoplasms. Thymocytes express CD3 at different level on the cell surface in the course of differentiation and, in cortical thymus, CD3 is predominantly Intracytoplasmic. This monoclonal antibody is particularly useful for induction of T cell activation in vitro and in vivo due to its unusual IgG3 isotype.
