Grp94 shows a high degree of sequence homology with the heat shock protein 90 (hsp90). This monoclonal antibody is highly specific to grp94 and shows minimal cross-reaction with other members of the HSP90 family. Grps are a class of proteins unresponsive to heat shock and are induced by glucose deprivation. Grp94 has been briefly studied as a prognostic factor in breast cancer.
