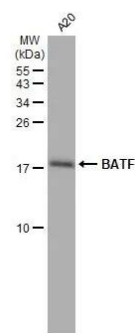

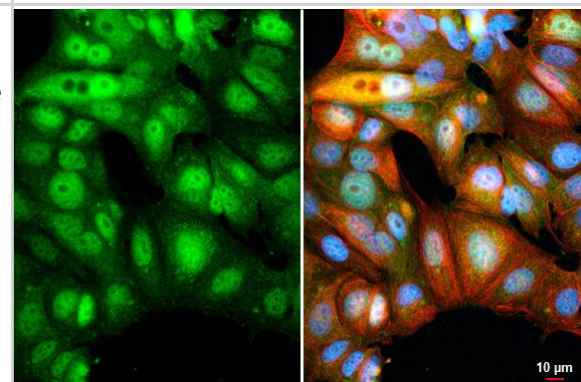

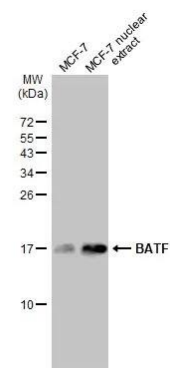
Western Blot: BATF Antibody (HL1870) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP3-25377] - Whole cell extract (30 ug) was separated by 15% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with BATF antibody [HL1870] (NBP3-25377) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody.



Immunocytochemistry/Immunofluorescence: BATF Antibody (HL1870) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP3-25377] - BATF antibody [HL1870] detects BATF protein by immunofluorescent analysis. Sample: MCF-7 cells were fixed in 4% paraformaldehyde at RT for 15 min. Green: BATF stained by BATF antibody [HL1870] (NBP3-25377) diluted at 1:500. Red: alpha Tubulin, a cytoskeleton marker, stained by alpha Tubulin antibody [GT114] (NBP2-43837) diluted at 1:1000. Blue: Fluoroshield with DAPI. Scale bar= 10um.



Western Blot: BATF Antibody (HL1870) - Azide and BSA Free [NBP3-25377] - MCF-7 whole cell and nuclear extracts (30 ug) were separated by 15% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with BATF antibody [HL1870] (NBP3-25377) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody, and the signal was developed with Trident ECL plus-Enhanced.
