Western Blot: Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 Antibody (A6-C0-B9-R) [NBP3-32388] - Western blot analysis of Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 on different lysates with Mouse anti-Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/1,000 dilution.

Proteins were transferred to a PVDF membrane and blocked with 5% NFDM/TBST for 1 hour at room temperature. The primary antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/1,000 dilution was used in 5% NFDM/TBST at 4 overnight. Goat Anti-Mouse IgG - HRP Secondary Antibody at 1/50,000 dilution was used for 1 hour at room temperature.

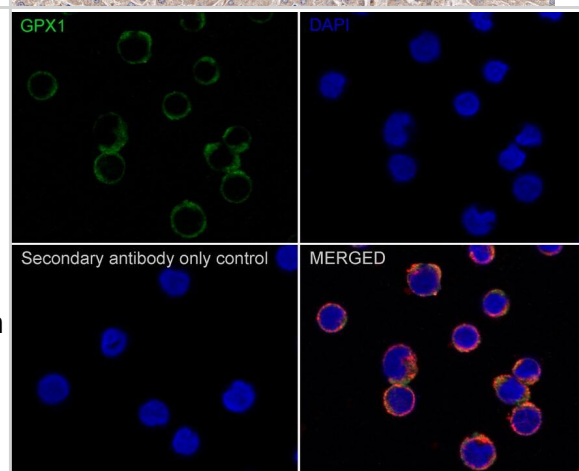
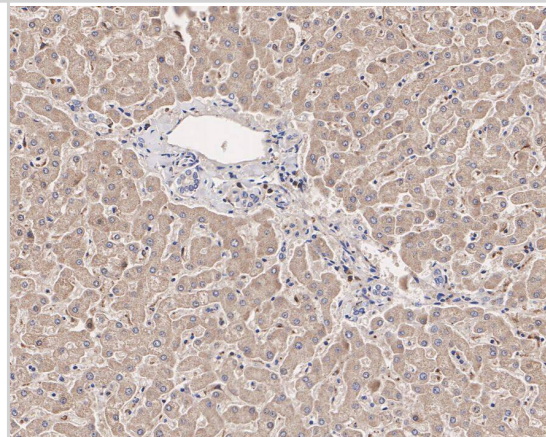
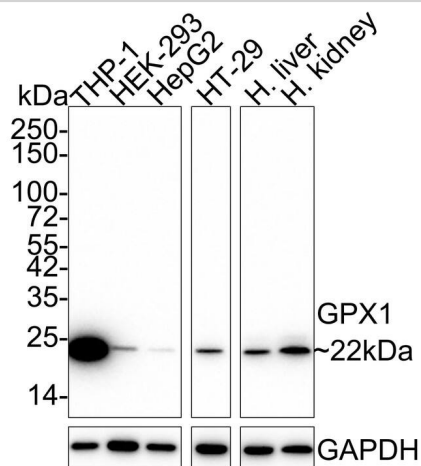
Immunohistochemistry: Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 Antibody (A6-C0-B9-R) [NBP3-32388] - Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human liver tissue with Mouse anti-Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/200 dilution.

The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0) for 20 minutes. The tissues were blocked in 1% BSA for 20 minutes at room temperature, washed with ddH₂O and PBS, and then probed with the primary antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/200 dilution for 1 hour at room temperature. The detection was performed using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. Tissues were counterstained with hematoxylin and mounted with DPX.

Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence: Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 Antibody (A6-C0-B9-R) [NBP3-32388] - Immunocytochemistry analysis of THP-1 cells labeling Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 with Mouse anti-Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/100 dilution.

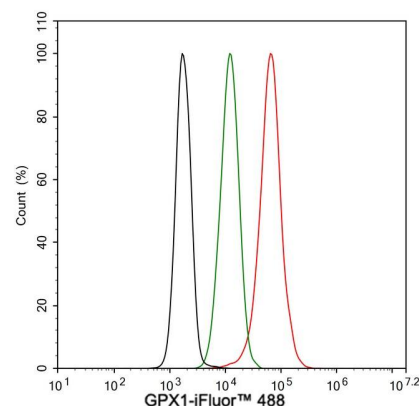
Cells were fixed in 80% precooled methanol for 5 minutes at room temperature, then blocked with 1% BSA in 10% negative goat serum for 1 hour at room temperature. Cells were then incubated with Mouse anti-Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 antibody (NBP3-32388) at 1/100 dilution in 1% BSA in PBST overnight at 4 °C. Goat Anti-Mouse IgG H&L (iFluor™ 488) was used as the secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution. PBS instead of the primary antibody was used as the secondary antibody only control. Nuclear DNA was labelled in blue with DAPI.

beta Tubulin (red) was stained at 1/100 dilution overnight at +4 °C. Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (iFluor™ 594) were used as the secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution.



Flow Cytometry: Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1 Antibody (A6-C0-B9-R) [NBP3-32388] - Flow cytometric analysis of THP-1 cells labeling Glutathione Peroxidase 1/GPX1.

Cells were fixed and permeabilized. Then stained with the primary antibody (NBP3-32388, 1 μ g/mL) (red) compared with Mouse IgG1 Isotype Control (green). After incubation of the primary antibody at +4 $^{\circ}$ C for an hour, the cells were stained with a iFluorTM 488 conjugate-Goat anti-Mouse IgG Secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution for 30 minutes at +4 $^{\circ}$ C. Unlabelled sample was used as a control (cells without incubation with primary antibody; black).
