Western Blot: Lamin B Receptor Antibody (PSH02-93) [NBP3-32519] - Western blot analysis of Lamin B Receptor on different lysates with Rabbit anti-Lamin B Receptor antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/2,000 dilution.

Lane 1: HEK-293 cell lysate

Lane 2: HeLa cell lysate

Lane 3: Jurkat cell lysate

Lysates/proteins at 20 ug/Lane.

Predicted band size: 71 kDa

Observed band size: 58 kDa

Exposure time: Lane 1-2: 1 minute 2 seconds; Lane 3: 5 seconds;

4-20% SDS-PAGE gel.

Proteins were transferred to a PVDF membrane and blocked with 5% NFDM/TBST for 1 hour at room temperature. The primary antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/2,000 dilution was used in 5% NFDM/TBST at 4 overnight. Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG - HRP Secondary Antibody at 1/50,000 dilution was used for 1 hour at room temperature.




Immunohistochemistry: Lamin B Receptor Antibody (PSH02-93) [NBP3-32519] - Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human small intestine tissue with Rabbit anti-Lamin B Receptor antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/10,000 dilution.

The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with sodium citrate buffer (pH 6.0) for 2 minutes. The tissues were blocked in 1% BSA for 20 minutes at room temperature, washed with ddH₂O and PBS, and then probed with the primary antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/10,000 dilution for 1 hour at room temperature. The detection was performed using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. Tissues were counterstained with hematoxylin and mounted with DPX.

Immunocytochemistry/ Immunofluorescence: Lamin B Receptor Antibody (PSH02-93) [NBP3-32519] - Immunocytochemistry analysis of HEK-293 cells labeling Lamin B Receptor with Rabbit anti-Lamin B Receptor antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/2,000 dilution.


Cells were fixed in 100% precooled methanol for 5 minutes at room temperature, then blocked with 1% BSA in 10% negative goat serum for 1 hour at room temperature. Cells were then incubated with Rabbit anti-Lamin B Receptor antibody (NBP3-32519) at 1/2,000 dilution in 1% BSA in PBST overnight at 4 °C. Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (iFluor™ 488) was used as the secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution. PBS instead of the primary antibody was used as the secondary antibody only control. Nuclear DNA was labelled in blue with DAPI.

Beta tubulin (red) was stained at 1/100 dilution overnight at +4 °C. Goat Anti-Mouse IgG H&L (iFluor™ 594) was used as the secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution.



Flow Cytometry: Lamin B Receptor Antibody (PSH02-93) [NBP3-32519]
- Flow cytometric analysis of HEK-293 cells labeling Lamin B Receptor.

Cells were fixed and permeabilized. Then stained with the primary antibody (NBP3-32519, 1:1,000) (red) compared with Rabbit IgG Isotype Control (green). After incubation of the primary antibody at +4°C for an hour, the cells were stained with a iFluor™ 488 conjugate-Goat anti-Rabbit IgG Secondary antibody at 1/1,000 dilution for 30 minutes at +4°C. Unlabelled sample was used as a control (cells without incubation with primary antibody; black).
