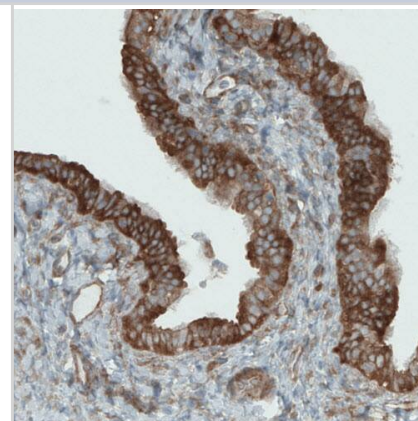

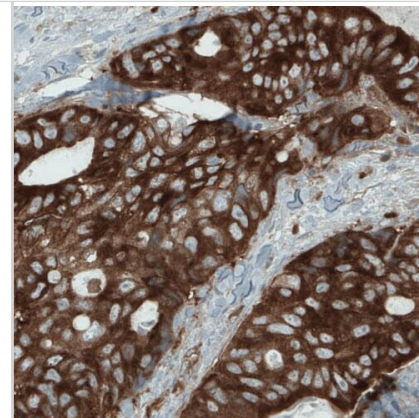

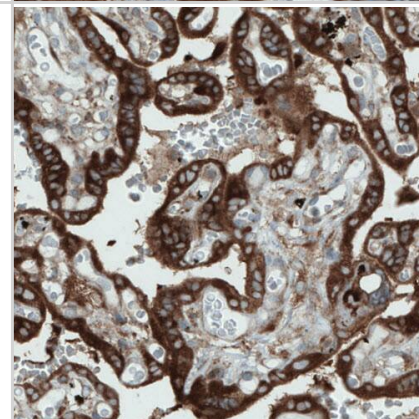
Staining of human fallopian tube shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in epithelial cells.



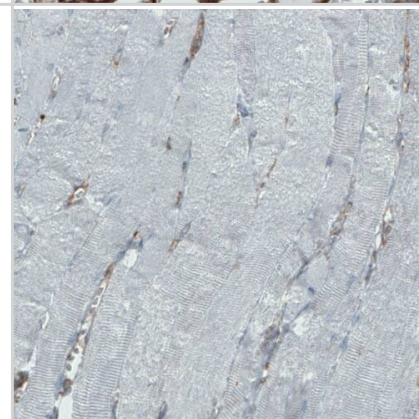
Staining of human colorectal cancer shows strong cytoplasmic immunoreactivity in tumor cells.



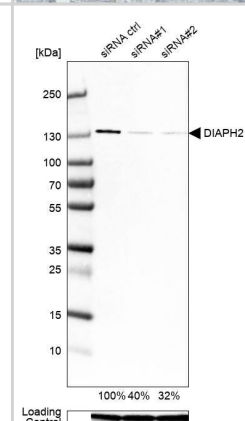
Staining of human placenta shows strong staining in the trophoblast.



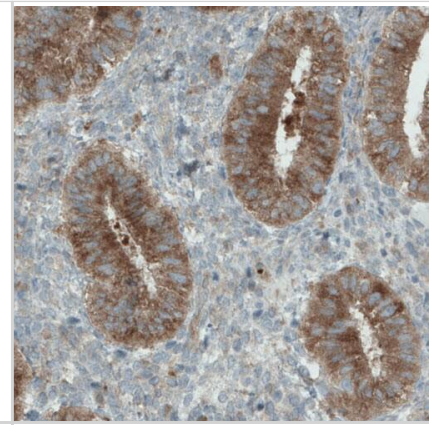
Staining of human skeletal muscle shows absence of immunoreactivity (negative control).



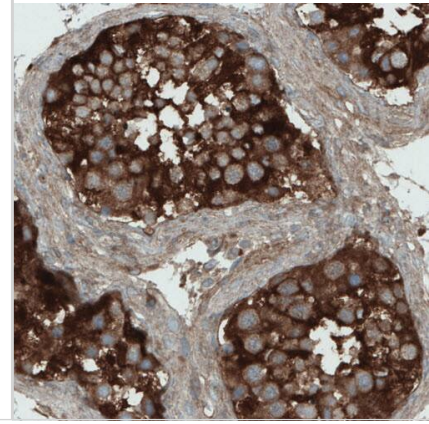
